

RED

🙁 Red, bloody discharge may indicate an issue. If you have more than a few streaks, call your doctor.

PINK

🙁 Pink signifies blood; it don't necessarily mean anything is wrong, but it is a good idea to consult you doctor

GREY

🙁 Thin, grey, fishy-smelling discharge could mean you have an infection like bacterial vaginosis

CLEAR

😊 Clear/whitish, mild-smelling discharge, called leukorrhea is normal during pregnancy
😊 In late pregnancy, clear stringy discharge is likely part of the mucus plug which is normal

CREAM

🙁 Leukorrhea can also be a creamy hue (like skim milk) but if you have itching/burning it may be a yeast infection

TAN

🙁 Discharge the color of coffee could mean you have a yeast infection, especially if it's clumpy and has an unusual smell

GREEN

🙁 Green, foul-smelling discharge could be a sign of an infection like chlamydia or trichomoniasis

DARK BROWN

🙁 It may be dried blood. If it's a jelly-like consistency, it could be part of your mucus plug, but if you have more than a few streak you may want to contact your doctor

YELLOW

🙁 Yellow vaginal discharge may be a sign of an infection. You may want to contact your doctor
